Chase Terrace Technology College offers one of the broadest choices of sixth form courses in the local area (30 courses) and its record of success is equally impressive, with 48% of all 2015 Advanced level entries being graded A*, A or B, 73% graded C or above and a 98% pass rate.

Tech Bacc ... to the future!

The school is constantly reviewing its curriculum and is introducing a new BTEC Level 3 course in Engineering from September - a really exciting new venture for the school. The combination of this course, together with AS or A level Maths and the Extended Project Qualification, provides a Technical Baccalaureate programme (the Government's new 'Tech Bacc'). Students gaining a Tech Bacc position themselves strongly to take up intermediate apprenticeship opportunities or a route into higher education / higher level apprenticeships. Engineering is an area of employment where relevant skills and qualifications are growing in demand, especially in this part of the country. Students will be able to combine the BTEC Engineering course with A level courses such as Maths, Physics, Product Design and Computer Science to provide a more practically orientated complement to these more traditional courses.

Chase Terrace employs a highly qualified careers advisor, who can help students to make the best course choices and inform their career planning. Furthermore, the school now has excellent links with local businesses and universities, which are used to help students to understand how their learning relates to the next steps that they will take. There is a very high degree of satisfaction for students in gaining places on degree courses at their first choice higher education institutions.

The sixth form students at Chase Terrace thrive on the sense of community and the friendly, lively, disciplined atmosphere in the Sixth Form. All students develop their leadership abilities through the school's Sixth Form Student Leadership Programme and many of them are involved in the very popular and successful Duke of Edinburgh Award scheme. Recent investment has taken the sixth form accommodation and study facilities to a new level. Sixth form students have their own study room, a dedicated, newly refurbished common room and a kitchen area, with a catering service provided for the sixth form community.

Headteacher, Stuart Jones, considers that the School's sixth form plays a centrally important role in the life of the school itself.
