On **Thursday 23 May 2019**, your child will be sitting the English Literature (Paper 2) examination and will need to hand in their text on their way into the exam hall. All parents/carers will be invoiced for missing texts at the following costs:

“The Strange Case of Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde”	£3.00
